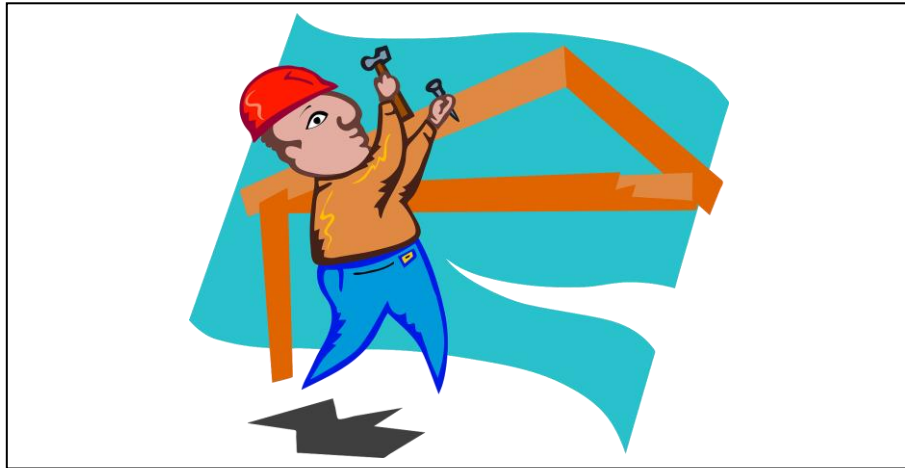
Ethan Roberts
